Post-graduate students are particularly encouraged to present papers at the conference.

Agri-Food XIII is jointly sponsored by the Centre for the Study of Agriculture Food and Environment (CSAFE) and the Agriculture Research Group on Sustainability (ARGOS). The conference will be highlighted by two symposia:

- The margins and interstices of the global food system: economies, people and ecologies
- Interdisciplinary research & agricultural sustainability

3. An abstract of not more than 250 words

The presentation format for papers not connected to the symposia will involve 20 minute slots in plenary sessions, followed by time for questions and answers. Because of time restrictions in the conference program, we will consider only one application per lead researcher.

Persons submitting papers after 30 June will be advised of their acceptance in a timely manner.
